

Melamines and Woods



Protect the surface

Use desk protectors to prevent damage from the most common items, such as computers, screens, mice, phones...



Avoid dragging objects

Whenever possible, try to lift objects instead of dragging them across the table.



Sunlight exposure

Avoid long exposure of the material to sunlight; melamine and wood may change color when exposed directly to the sun, aging the product prematurely.



Avoid placing glasses or cups directly on the table

Wet, excessively cold, or hot items weaken the surface, ruining the finish and creating rings and stains. Use protective coasters for these items.



Do not use paper towels

The use of cleaning cloths that are appropriate/specific for the material in question is recommended.



Harsh agents

Avoid exposing the RAIO product to high temperatures or humidity. Do not expose the RAIO product to environments with corrosive or abrasive agents. This may weaken or damage the product.



Cleaning

For regular maintenance, the material should be cleaned with a damp cloth soaked in neutral pH soap, or using a specific product for the material in question. Do not use abrasive or corrosive products.



Spills or Stains

In case of liquid spills, it should be dried as soon as possible. Water: Absorb with a cloth or sponge. Drinks: Clean with a damp cloth and dry the surface.

Metal Structures



Protect the surface

Regular dusting is recommended, using a non-abrasive, lint-free cloth.



Avoid getting wet

Avoid wetting or dampening moving parts and mechanisms.

Cleaning

For regular maintenance, the material should be cleaned with a non-abrasive cloth, or using a specific product for the material in question.



Do not use abrasive, corrosive or wax-based cleaning products.

Plastics (pvc, polyamide, nylon,...)

Castor Wheels

Castors and wheels should be cleaned periodically to prevent wheel blockages caused by dirt.

Fabric



Protect the surface

Vacuum fabrics regularly to prevent dust accumulation on the surface.



Cleaning

Remove splashes and stains as quickly as possible. Blot excess liquid with a paper towel or a damp cloth and then clean with specific upholstery products. Always use appropriate cleaning agents for fabric.

Never apply bleach, ammonia-based detergents, alkalines, or strong acids to upholstery.

Leather should be cleaned regularly with a soft, damp cloth. Appropriate leather cleaning cloths can be used for a more thorough finish.

Vinyl fabrics should be cleaned with warm water and neutral pH soap.

RAIO recommends that, for any fabric on its products, you always consult the manufacturer and their respective cleaning care.
